FUNDRAISING FOR 4TH AFENET SCIENTIFIC CONFERENCE

- **What** is AFENET? AFENET is an acronym for “African Field Epidemiology Network” who’s Secretariat is in **Kampala, Uganda**. AFENET works with Ministries of Health in 20 African countries namely: Angola, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Democratic Republic of Congo, Ethiopia, Burkina Faso, Mali, Niger, Togo, Ghana, Kenya, Mozambique, Nigeria, Rwanda, Sierra Leone, South Africa, South Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda, and Zimbabwe. The programs in the Network train epidemiologists and laboratorians in Public Health and Laboratory Management at Masters level. For more information, visit the AFENET website www.afenet.net.
- **When** is the Conference? The conference will take place from 11-16 December 2011.
- **Where** will the conference take place? The conference will be hosted by the Tanzania Ministry of Health and Social Welfare at the Bank of Tanzania Conference Centre in Dar es Salaam.
- **Who** is expected to attend? A premier and key networking event for epidemiologists and other public health practitioners in Africa, over 400 delegates are expected to attend from more than 20 African countries and from all over the world. These will include Ministers of Health from at least 10 African countries, officials from Ministries of Health and Ministries of Agriculture, trainees, faculty and alumni from FELTPs, and development partners. Ministers of Health from about 10 African countries will be present for a Ministerial Forum.
- **Why** fundraise? AFENET needs to raise about US\$ 400,000 to cover the core costs of the conference and the travel costs of some trainees and faculty.
- **What** benefits to Sponsors? The benefits will be in the categories of Tanzanite, Platinum, Gold and Silver, with contributions ranging from US\$ 5,000 to 25,000+ for Corporate and US\$ 5,000 to 50,000+ plus for Non-Corporate Organizations.
